



Hello,

The L.I.N.C. (Long-term Inmates Now in the Community) Society periodically sends televisions to people inside several of the federal prisons in the Fraser Valley. Amidst the COVID 19 crisis, we are currently experiencing a higher volume of requests than we can accommodate.

Given the present conditions inside prisons, having a television can make a big difference in someone's life. With all visits, ETA's/UTA's/Work Releases and programs suspended, having access to a T.V. means that an individual has more access to accurate information about COVID 19, and relief from the stress that sitting unoccupied in cells causes.

Once a television is delivered to a person in prison, it becomes their personal property. Every cell in a federal penitentiary is equipped with a cable outlet, and every federal prisoner pays a monthly cable bill whether they have a television or not.
